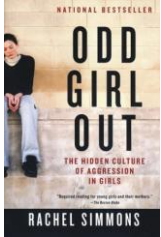

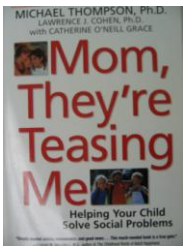


Book: Odd Girl Out

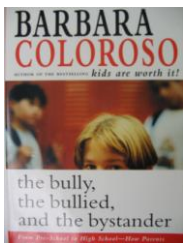


Book: Mom, They're Teasing Me: Helping Your Child Solve Social Problems

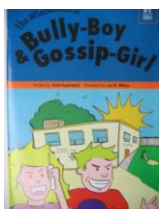


Book: The Bully, the Bullied, and the Bystander

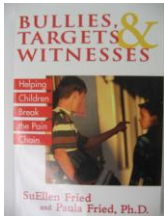

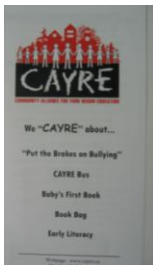

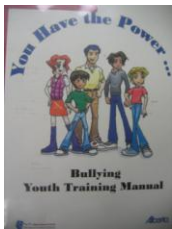
