Early childhood education and care practitioners work with one of the most vulnerable groups in society - young children. The quality of the interactions between young children and the adults who care for them has a significant, enduring impact on children's lives. The intimacy of the relationship and the potential to do harm calls for a commitment on our part to the highest standards of ethical practice.

This four-part series guides participants on a journey of ethical discovery and awareness. Participants will have the opportunity to explore personal values, beliefs and assumptions, and examine the complexities in ethical decision-making. Each module consists of approximately a three hour presentation. The program recommends a minimum of one month between sessions in order to allow participants to internalize concepts and reflect how principles guide practice once introduced. Module Four- Renewing Our Commitment to Best Choices works with participants in understanding how personal values, beliefs and ethics can support but also challenge ethical decision-making. Participants will also identify potential inhibitors to making these decisions. Through examination of the six E's to ethical commitment, participants will be able to renew their commitment of "best choice" decision making in practice. **In order to attend this session, all participants must have attended and successfully completed Module One, Two and Three of the Ethics- Best Choices sessions as a prerequisite. It is suggested that there be a minimum of 6 months between Module 3 and Module 4.**

- Examine and practice a process for ethical decision-making
- Recognize the complexity in best choice decision-making
- Recognize the many possible choices that exist
- Commit to ethical decision-making in practice
